The CES Waiver helps children under 18 and families by providing services to assist children in establishing a long-term foundation for community inclusion as they grow into adulthood. This program is specifically for children demonstrating a medical or behavioral condition where constant supervision is needed to keep the child and others safe.

## Am I eligible?

### Age

Under 18 years old

### Residence

Lives in family home

### Daily Living

Needs support with some or all daily activities

### Supervision

Requires constant line of sight to maintain safety

### Determination

Determined to have disability or delay (if under 5)

### Financial

*Long-term Medical Care Criteria* – Meets social security disability definition & financial requirements for Health First Colorado Medicaid
